



The kitchen remodel, shown here on the right, transformed the lives of the residents using wheelchairs and the staff of an adult group home. For the first time, the residents were able to participate in food preparation with the staff and could access the kitchen for a snack on their own. Promoting independence is a priority. Previously, the kitchen was inaccessible and the residents were totally dependent on their caretakers. Now, this change has boosted their confidence and independence.
